


Geographical coordinates, orientation on the map



Indicate correct answer (correct answers are marked in red):

1. The longitude difference between A and B is 5 °/10°.
2. Point C is located on NE / SE from Point B.
3. Day and night run evenly throughout the Year, 12 hours each at Point A / B.
4. The westernmost point is the A/D point.
5. The closest point to the cancer Tropic is C / D.
6. The difference in latitude between Point B and C is 5°/10°.
7. One degree of the Meridian arc has a length of about 111 km, which means that the parallel stretch between Point A and D is 1110/11100 km.
8. The earliest sunrise will be observed at A / D.
9. The value of the azimuth measured from point A to point B is approx. 65°/120°
