## Lesson Plan

### The influence of moral features on success in professional life

<b>Level, age of the students:</b>	14-16
<b>Subject:</b>	Theology
<b>Subjects involved:</b>	History, Philosophy, Psychology, Education, Sociology
<b>Aims:</b>	<p>To make students comprehend that moral characteristics such as honesty, integrity, reliability, hard work, patience and loyalty to work are indispensable elements of success, peace and happiness in career and business life.</p> <p>To introduce model personalities as an example in the development of these moral characteristics that will make a person successful in his career life.</p>
<b>Suggested # of students per group:</b>	20
<b>Time of the main activity:</b>	15'
<b>Material:</b>	Smart Board, Lecture notes, Resource books
<b>Competences:</b>	<p>Understands that it is necessary to have certain moral characteristics in order to be happy and successful in all areas of life.</p> <p>Realizes that the example of model personalities is also important in career and business life.</p> <p>Recognizes the life and struggles of model personalities. Comprehends their virtues and moral characteristics.</p>
